

Grading Policy

Achievement Grades

Grades are based on the grade level your child is in. To indicate your child's achievement in the areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking, mathematics, social studies, and science, I use the following scale:

A (90-100% on tests and class work) – Excellent quality work

B (80-89% on tests and class work) – Above average quality of work

C (70-79% on tests and class work) – Average quality of work

D (60-69% on tests and class work) – Below average quality of work

F (50-59% on tests and class work) – Work quality is below the minimum standard

Effort Grades

Students will also receive an effort grade in each academic area. Effort grades are given to show your child's effort and work habits and based on the following scale:

1 – Outstanding effort. Hardworking student, does more than is required.

2 – Effort shown. Does what is required.

3. – Effort needs to improve. Consistently does less than what is required.
