



Homework:

Homework is important because it is a valuable aid in helping your child make the most of his/her experience in school. I give homework because it is useful in reinforcing what has been learned in class, teaches responsibility and helps your child develop positive study habits. Homework also allows you to see first hand your child's strengths and weaknesses and the ability to follow directions.

Every **Monday**, your child will be receiving his/her homework folder and it needs to be returned on **Thursday**. Inside the homework folder you will find the homework worksheet/s and books for your child to read and keep. You can help your child read these books and record them on the B.E.A.R. Book Club Reading Form. You may also record books from home.

You will also find notes that may need to be signed and returned or are for your informational purpose only and can be kept at home. Please watch for special notes.

Parents, you play an important role in making homework a positive experience for your child. Therefore, I ask that parents make homework a top priority, provide necessary supplies, a quiet homework environment and provide praise and support. I also expect students to do their best job on their homework and that it be the child's work and the parents written response if needed. During the course of the year your child will be able to do his/her own written responses.

If homework is not completed or returned on time he/she will receive a "sad note" and sit on the bench during recess. If you have questions about the homework please contact me prior to the due date.
