## CONSEQUENCES AND REWARDS



### Color Cards

**Color Cards** are a way for me to communicate with you at home. Each day your child starts off on Green, **READY TO LEARN**, for one reason or another, your child may be asked to move their name clip down during the day. Therefore the color card sent home will change. If your child goes above and beyond the normal expectancies they will get to move their name clip up.

We use a **Respect Chart** that reflects the Charter Counts Pillars that are emphasized in the classroom and throughout the District. An example of the chart is below:



Your child is aware of the **Respect Chart** and understands the process of moving their clip up or down. Eventually your child will be able to move their name to the spot marked “Super Student.” They will be able to do this when your child is going above and beyond regular school requirements.

**\*\*It is important that you as parents/guardians ask your child for their color cards each day so you are aware of how their day went. Please feel free to ask questions anytime.\*\***
