Positive Consequences

When you choose to respect the expectations, you may earn one or more of the following rewards:

Negative Consequences

- *If you choose to not respect the expectations:*
- Students will first be given a verbal warning.
- If behavior continues the student will lose a recess.
- If behavior progresses the student will either lose privileges within the classroom and/or render payment to the teacher in the form of tickets.
- Finally, when behavior is not modified the student will be sent to the office, and/or parent contact will be made depending on the severity and nature of the behavior.
