

Grading Policy

Grading policy will be as follows:

100 - 90 = A

89 - 80 = B

79 - 70 = C

69 - 60 = D

59 and below = F (Failing)

When I ask a student to complete an assignment and they complete it as asked they will receive a C grade for following directions. If a student does extra work they will earn bonus points increasing their grade. For example: If I asked a student to explain what a Fable is and they say:

C: A Fable is a story that has a lesson or a moral at the end.

B: A Fable is a story that uses Personification to teach a lesson or a moral. One such Fable is the Tortoise and the Hare.
