

Classroom Management

In order to make this school year productive, I ask that your son or daughter understand the expected behavior. I have introduced a behavior system. All students will begin the day on “ready to learn” and start fresh every day. The students will be able to move up and down the chart all day. The students will each have a clothespin with their name on it. When a student follows the rules they will be asked to “clip up” a level. Whenever a student chooses to not follow the rules, he/she will be given a verbal warning. If the behavior continues he/she will be asked to “clip down” a level. Students can move back up a level or more throughout the day for modifying the behavior. If the behavior continues or the student chooses not to follow another rule, he/she will be asked to clip down a level until they reach the “parent contact” level. If a student is on this level or by the end of the day, I will write a response in their planner or I will call the parent to notify them of the inappropriate behavior.

There are five rules that my students are asked to follow.

Listen when others are talking.

Follow directions the first time they are given.

Raise your hand and wait for permission to speak

Stay in your seat unless you have permission to get up.

Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.

No teasing.

You will always know how your child behaved in class by looking at their planner for that day.
