Consequences

▶ If materials are not readily available, you will need to purchase replacements.

▶ If you show disrespect in any manner or show an uncaring attitude, you will write a letter of apology.

▶ If you are dishonest, a parent will be notified and you will write a letter of apology.

▶ If you litter or do not help keep the classroom clean, you will spend recess cleaning.

▶ If you show poor sportsmanship, you will lose the privilege of playing a game or participating in an activity.

▶ If you continue to choose to NOT be a person of good character, you will lose all classroom and school privileges.
