

Health & Safety Bond Passes!

I am excited to announce that the WUSD Health & Safety Bond passed by a margin of 53% (2,519 votes) to 47% (2,228 votes). We are humbled by the outcome and grateful for a supportive community who makes the health and safety of their children a priority.

It will now be our job to be good stewards of the resources we have been blessed to receive and to keep our community informed of the progress we make in implementing the bond. To that end the planning process has already begun. We are starting to talk with our bond underwriter about next steps and have developed a calendar of events to occur throughout the remainder of this school year.

At this stage we plan to sell the bonds around April of this school year and will begin some of the work during the summer months. In the weeks to come a preliminary schedule will be established related to the projects and purchases to be made. I fully expect that this will be at least a three year process as all phases of the process are completed.

We plan to provide regular updates to the community, which will focus on both budget detail and project status. You can look for ongoing information under the “bond” tab on the WUSD website and we will also produce quarterly and annual reports.
