

Synergy Features for Wickenburg High School

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The Technology department is working with our schools to prepare for the 2016-2017 school year. This process will provide additional features through Synergy (our student information system) to ensure all students are scheduled and ready to go in the fall. Preparing our students to be college and career ready is the focus of our schools and the use of technology is a key way WUSD is trying to make that happen. Wickenburg School District uses a student information system called Synergy. Synergy offers many features to students and parents that weren't available in our old system.

At the high school level, Synergy allows parents to view their child's course selections for the following year. Counselors are working with students over the next month to select those courses. As families, you will then be able to look at your child's course selections to make sure that you that you are comfortable with your child's 4-year plan.

Wickenburg High School offers a wide array of courses. Families have a lot of choices to make. Do you want your child to take regular classes or honors/AP (Advanced Placement) classes? How would you like your child to take those classes? We offer classes in person in traditional classroom settings. We also offer them in a blended format, which means students are in a classroom at the high school with a certified content teacher working on a computer based digital course. Or students can take a class virtually online at home...there are many options.

In addition to selecting classes for their core subjects, students will be able to select from a variety of elective classes. Some of the elective classes at WHS give students the opportunity to earn both college and high school credit, some allow students to earn a math credit in a career and technical class instead of in a traditional math classroom and others meet the entrance requirements for university fine arts and career and technical classes.

As parents, if you have a ParentVUE account, you will see your child's finished requests through ParentVUE. In addition, the high school will be sending home a Course Sheet with your child's requests for you to sign. Returning this form with your signature or requested changes will provide you and your child the courses they need and want.
