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### **Intro to JavaScript Programming with Animation (Easy)**

This class will introduce students to the basics of programming by teaching them to create and control basic shapes and graphics. 6th grade math level recommended.

### **Vet Camp**

Prepare for a career in the veterinary field where students will learn some of the skills that will allow them to work with all creatures, large and small. In this camp you will learn how to build and program a robot as part of a team of 4 students. We will use VEX IQ as our building platform. VEX IQ is a type of lego building material, so your robot will be stuck together. Depending on time, students may compete against the other teams.

### **Babysitting Basics**

Do you like children? Do you want to be able to earn some extra money? This class is for you. Students will learn about why children do the things they do, how to care for children, and how to run a babysitting business. Students will take away a babysitting certificate and a beginning babysitter's bag with some of the tools to use when caring for children.

### **Fire Science and EMT**

Students will be introduced to basic fire science fundamentals and have a great time stretching fire hoses, dressing out in real firefighters gear and cross-fit training. ### **Cosmetology**

### **Digital Photography**

Students will learn basic photography concepts such as exposure, ISO, white balance and depth of field as well as introductory Adobe Lightroom and Photoshop application. The course is taught using school DSLRs (Rebel T3is). Cameras may be provided or participants may bring their own DSLR camera. Point and shoot and film cameras will not be accepted. Students will select their best shots to turn into large prints.

### **Art Exploration**

Each week students will be exposed to a different art concept. The course fee is \$40 per week or \$200 for all 6 weeks! All classes are from 8am – 11am.

June 8 – June 11 **Painting** – Learn about how shapes and lines can be combined to create a masterpiece using many different methods of techniques, textures, and types of paints.

June 15 – June 18 **Portrait** – Learn to draw portraits using different styles and techniques with pencil, paint, and different styles of papers.

June 22 – 26 **Mixed Media Painting** - Explore all the different materials that can be mixed into acrylics and have an amazing finish.

June 19 – July 2 **3-D Art** - Use clay, mesh and many different materials to create a unique masterpiece.

July 6 – July 9 **Mythical Beasts** – Create a character half human and half animal using a variety of techniques and mediums. Then write a fantastical story about this creation!
