

PARENT INFORMATION PACKET

General Information:

Elementary summer school will meet at Ellsworth Elementary, Monday – Thursday from 8:00 – 11:00 am from June 5 – 29, 2017. Students may take a minimum of one class or a maximum of two classes. Tuition is on a per class basis. The first session is 8:00 – 9:25 am. Session two will meet from 9:35 – 11:00 am. Tuition:

The cost is \$65 per class. Some courses may have an additional supply fee. Please check the course description for additional fees.

Online Registration:

Please look through the course descriptions and schedule that follows. All registration is online and detailed instructions are on page 6. To register for summer school, please go to the "Summer School" webpage listed under the "Community Education" tab on the www.jocombs.org website. If you do not have access to a computer, please visit the Community Education office located at the District Office, from 8:00 am – 3:30 pm, Monday – Friday. All course fees are due at the time of registration. MasterCard and Visa will be accepted. Please register early. There are maximum limits for each class and registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis. Your registration will be confirmed by e-mail. Registration is only online and is not complete until courses have been selected and payment has been made.

Refunds/Schedule Changes:

Classes will be carried only upon sufficient enrollment. In the event a class does not meet enrollment requirements, you will be notified and full payment will be refunded. There will be **no refunds** unless enrollment is not sufficient. The Community Education Department reserves the right to combine classes.

Transportation:

Transportation is available for students attending both summer school sessions. The summer school transportation fee is \$40/family/school location. Please choose and pay for the transportation option when you register online. The transportation office will contact each registered family with bus stop information. The bus routes will not be established until the Friday preceding summer school. **Please wait for your phone call from the transportation office**. All transportation questions can be directed to 480-987-5309, selection Option 2.

Dress Code: Summer School follows the same dress code as the regular school year.

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Course Descriptions

Physical Education

<u>Dance</u>: 5-6-7-8 ...In this dance class students will learn basic technique, timing and coordination through a choreographed routine that will encourage teamwork and build on individual skills. We are building confidence through dance and having fun while doing it!



<u>Cheer!</u>: Go TEAM! Future cheerleaders will start with basic moves and showing team spirit and progress into chants and cheers. Your enthusiastic youngster won't want to miss this class!

<u>Fitness Fun K-3:</u> Our K-3 fitness fun summer class is a great opportunity for your child to be active and continue to develop fundamental skills in a physical education setting. Students will participate in many different activities designed to enhance cooperative play, movement skills, manipulative skills and fitness concepts. Some activities that your student will participate in include; several different tags, scooter and parachute games, as well as various jump roping, tossing, catching and modified sports activities for K-3 students.

<u>Fitness Fun 4-6:</u> Our 4-6 fitness fun summer class will serve as a great way to keep your child active while developing important skills in a physical education setting. Students will participate in a variety of activities that will be designed to increase levels of fitness, develop sport specific skills and encourage positive sportsmanship. This summer, your student will participate in the following sporting activities; basketball, volleyball, softball (whiffle ball) and soccer.

S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering & Math)



KID APPROVED Healthy, Hands on Cooking and Advanced Kid Approved Healthy, Hands on Cooking:

Students will learn about making yummy, family friendly, and healthy meals and snacks. Kids will also learn about measuring, following recipes, and making healthy eating fun and simple. If your child has any food allergy, it is strongly recommended that they DO NOT enroll in this class without discussing with instructors if we can work around the allergy. Caution: This class may use peanut, dairy, and/or meat products. \$10 additional supply fee

<u>Grossology!</u>: Every student loves the world of gross things! This class is mind-boggling! Explore why your body produces mushy, oozy, crusty, scaly, and smelly gunk, including our animal friends. Students will make hands-on yucky stuff. In the end you will be a "Specialized Grossologist!" Students will also integrate math, reading & writing with scientific inquiry. \$10 additional supply fee



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<u>Science Fun for Everyone:</u> Welcome to the amazing world of science! Young scientists will explore a variety of topics and document their discoveries in journals. Week 1: LEGO madness, Week 2: Foodie Science, Week 3: The Human Body, Week 4: Crime Scene Investigations . \$10 additional supply fee

<u>Dinosaurs - ROAR!</u>: Students become an archeologist discovering when dinosaurs roamed the Earth, what types inhabited different eras, and characteristics of each. Students will even excavate their own fossils! \$15 additional supply fee



<u>Radical Reptiles:</u> Students will have an extremely fun time exploring reptiles of all shapes, sizes and colors. With some of the world's largest reptiles, like constrictors all the way to small reptiles like geckos, the fun never ends. This reptile class is a completely hands-on experience that the children will talk about for years to come. *Caution:* Live reptiles will be part of the classroom experience.


Roller Coaster Madness: Students take on the role of engineers who need to design a roller coaster. They will learn about the history of roller coasters, the different types, and the many things that affect roller coaster success. Finally they use a variety of Internet resources to guide them as they design their own roller coaster and test it for success. \$10 additional supply fee



<u>LEGO Robotics:</u> In this class, students will construct and program a robot as part of a 4 person team. Students will learn basic programming language, communication skills, and teamwork. (Classes limited to 16 students)

Fine Art Classes

<u>Art:</u> The fundamentals of painting and drawing will be the primary emphasis. Students will learn how to combine colors to make different shades and new techniques to get the right look. Come prepared to get messy and wear old clothes as acrylic paints do stain. \$10 additional supply fee



<u>Krafty Kids:</u> Plan to explore your creativity in areas such as painting, mosaic art, weaving, paper crafting and lots more. We will also find fun and artistic ways to use recycled everyday items like newspaper, paper towel rolls and water bottles. Come join in the fun! \$10 additional supply fee



<u>Summer Theater:</u> We proudly present a Broadway experience unlike any other. Students will take familiar stories and turn them into live productions. Learn what it takes to be a performer and ways to connect to an audience. Then perform live in front of parents & community. \$10 additional supply fee

<u>Babysitting 101 and First Aid Basics:</u> This class will teach students how to be caring, responsible, and fun babysitters. Students will take away a babysitting certificate and a beginning babysitter's bag with some of the tools to use when caring for children. \$10 additional supply fee

Summer Authors!:

Have you always wanted to write a book? This summer you can take your ideas and creativity and turn them into a book. We will learn elements of a story, character development and setting. Students will create a 66 page book (33 pages for text and 33 pages for illustrations). The book will also include a hardcover, a title, and dedication and author pages. Completed, printed books will be handed out or available for pick up the first week of school. \$20 additional fee for book

Online Registration Instructions

- 1. If you have an account with any other Community Education program, please log into your DayCare Works account at https://family.daycareworks.com and select Members. (Or choose "Existing account" link on the Summer School webpage.) If you cannot remember your family login, please contact Community Education at 480-987-5310. If you cannot remember your password, select Password Reminder and follow the prompts. If you need to add a student to your account, please do that first under the "Personal" tab.
- 2. Use the "Registration" tab to register for summer school classes, select Elementary Enrichment Summer School, and select the class and student. You may continue to add classes and/or students by clicking Add More.
- 3. If you do NOT have an account, please visit www.jocombs.org and select the Community Education tab Summer School link. Click New Account, Elementary Enrichment Summer School and the desired class. Complete the information for your first child. All fields marked with * are required.
- 4. Before checking out, you may Add Student to include siblings.
- 5. The transportation fee is one time per family per school location (for example: Two elementary aged siblings will pay 1 transportation fee of \$40. A high school summer school student with a sibling in elementary summer school, both needing transportation, will pay for 2 transportation fees \$80 total.) To ensure transportation on the first day of summer school, please make sure to register no later than May 19.
- 6. All registrations & additional summer school information will be confirmed via e-mail. The transportation office will call all families registered for transportation on the Friday preceding summer school (June 2). Please wait for the transportation office to call you.
