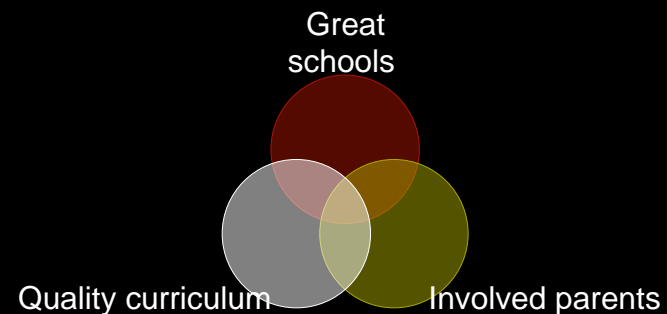

# Harmon Elementary

---

- School Wide Title Program (50% Free and Reduced lunch rate) 2014-2015 school year

- PLC school- we use data effectively as a school to meet needs of students

# Student Participation in Title 1

---

- Each student at Harmon is assessed and students that demonstrate academic need in Reading and Math are eligible for Title I services. Title I services = intervention to improve academic success.
- Title I teachers analyze AIMS records, AZ Merit test results, DIBELS assessments, STAR Reading, Galileo and Grade Level Assessments with teacher recommendation to determine and review student eligibility regularly.
