1. Arizona Board of Regents High Honors Tuition Scholarship 2014-2015

Available to all qualified 2015 seniors who plan on attending an Arizona university: ASU, NAU or U of A. The Arizona Board of Regents High Honors Tuition Scholarship (a.k.a. – AIMS Scholarship) is a university academic merit scholarship administered by the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) on behalf of the Arizona Board of Regents. Qualified students who graduate from high school will receive a 25% in-state university base tuition scholarship. Students must be a graduate from an Arizona high school, have Arizona residency with lawful immigration status AND meet the following academic criteria: Students must complete all 16 Core Competency Courses by graduation with a B or better in each course OR AN ACCEPTABLE SCORE (SEE TABLE 1) ON THE ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) TEST OR 4 ON THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) EXAM FOR THAT SUBJECT MATTER; CORE GPA of 3.50 in the 16 competency courses on an unweighted 4.00 scale; be in top 5% of their high school graduating class and EXCEED Standards on all 3 of the AIMS Tests by the end of your Junior year or EXCEED Standards on 2 of the AIMS Tests and MEET Standards on 1 of the AIMS Tests by the end of your Junior year. Additionally, they would either need to receive a minimum score of 3 on any two Advanced Placement tests OR a minimum score of 4 on any two International Baccalaureate exams. Students must meet at least one of the following admissions test options and submit scores to the universities they apply to: AT LEAST 28 on the ACT test; AT LEAST 1300 on the SATI test (critical reading & math, excluding essay). There is not an “application” associated with this scholarship opportunity. Each high school will compile a list of their students who meet the High Honors qualifications based upon completion of the 6th semester of high school (end of junior year.) High schools will provide this list to the Arizona Department of Education by October 15th of each year. Additional certifications will be made by each high school June 15th and July 30th. 4. Kids' Chance Scholarships For The Future

Ages 16 – 25

No Deadline

Grants awarded to children of Arizona workers who have been fatally or seriously injured in a valid work-related accident resulting in a financial need to complete their education. To qualify for help, the parent's work-related injury or death must have led to a substantial decline in family income. The applicant must be between the ages of 16 and 25 and meet academic standards set by Kids' Chance of Arizona. The scholarship is good for one semester, but the applicant must maintain acceptable grades each quarter in order to continue. See application at www.azkidschance.org.

5. The Jason Howell Memorial Scholarship Technology and Industrial Programs

Grade 12

Deadline is Open

This scholarship is in memory of Jason Howell and will be awarded to someone who is a U.S. Citizen and interested in Technology, Industrial, and Vocational Skills Programs. These programs consist of but are not limited to, welding, electrical, automotive, refrigeration, auto cad, air conditioning, carpentry, roofing and/or technical trade schools. 6. Federal Student Aid, Teach Grant Program

Grade 12

Deadline is Open: You should contact the financial aid office at the college where you will be enrolled at in the fall of 2015.

The TEACH Grant program provides grants of up to \$4,000 per year to students who intend to teach in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families. To receive a TEACH Grant you must meet the following criteria: Complete the FAFSA, be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, be enrolled in a college that has chosen to participate in the TEACH Grant Program, be enrolled in coursework that is necessary to begin a career in teaching, meet certain academic achievement requirements etc. See <https://studentaid.ed.gov/types/grants-scholarships/teach> for details of all the requirements.

7. American Legion Scholarships and Grants

8. American Legion Auxiliary H. H. Donkersley Post 19 Scholarship
Grade 12

Deadline **April 1, 2015**

U.S. Citizenship is required and applicants must be a veteran or related to a veteran (through a parent, grandparent, great-grandparent, sibling, spouse.) Scholarships are for \$500 (\$250 each semester) and can be used to attend a school of higher learning, junior college or university, or trade or vocational school in or out of the state of Arizona. Wilna G. Tygum Scholarship (\$1,000) Be accepted by and plan to enroll in the Nursing Program at an Arizona college or be a current student in good standing in the Nursing Program at an Arizona college; graduate of an Arizona high school; financial need as determined by FAFSA.
