1. ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS HIGH HONORS TUITION SCHOLARSHIP 2014-2015

AVAILABLE TO ALL QUALIFIED 2015 SENIORS WHO PLAN ON ATTENDING AN ARIZONA UNIVERSITY: ASU, NAU OR U OF A. THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENT'S HIGH HONORS TUITION SCHOLARSHIP (A.K.A. – AIMS SCHOLARSHIP) IS A UNIVERSITY ACADEMIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTERED BY THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (ADE) ON BEHALF OF THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS. QUALIFIED STUDENTS WHO GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL WILL RECEIVE A 25% IN-STATE UNIVERSITY BASE TUITION SCHOLARSHIP. STUDENTS MUST BE A GRADUATE FROM AN ARIZONA HIGH SCHOOL, HAVE ARIZONA RESIDENCY WITH LAWFUL IMMIGRATION STATUS AND MEET THE FOLLOWING ACADEMIC CRITERIA: STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE ALL 16 CORE COMPETENCY COURSES BY GRADUATION WITH A B OR BETTER IN EACH COURSE OR AN ACCEPTABLE SCORE (SEE TABLE 1) ON THE ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) TEST OR 4 ON THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) EXAM FOR THAT SUBJECT MATTER; CORE GPA of 3.50 IN THE 16 COMPETENCY COURSES ON AN UNWEIGHTED 4.00 SCALE; BE IN TOP 5% OF THEIR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATING CLASS AND EXCEED STANDARDS ON ALL 3 OF THE AIMS TESTS BY THE END OF YOUR JUNIOR YEAR OR EXCEED STANDARDS ON 2 OF THE AIMS TESTS AND MEET STANDARDS ON 1 OF THE AIMS TESTS BY THE END OF YOUR JUNIOR YEAR. ADDITIONALLY, THEY WOULD EITHER NEED TO RECEIVE A MINIMUM SCORE OF 3 ON ANY TWO ADVANCED PLACEMENT TESTS OR A MINIMUM SCORE OF 4 ON ANY TWO INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE EXAMS. STUDENTS MUST MEET AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ADMISSIONS TEST OPTIONS AND SUBMIT SCORES TO THE UNIVERSITIES THEY APPLY TO: AT LEAST 28 ON THE ACT TEST; AT LEAST 1300 ON THE SAT1 TEST (CRITICAL READING & MATH, EXCLUDING ESSAY). THERE IS NOT AN "APPLICATION" ASSOCIATED WITH THIS SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY. EACH HIGH SCHOOL WILL COMPILE A LIST OF THEIR STUDENTS WHO MEET THE HIGH HONORS QUALIFICATIONS BASED UPON COMPLETION OF THE 6TH SEMESTER OF HIGH SCHOOL (END OF JUNIOR YEAR.) THE TEACH GRANT PROGRAM PROVIDES GRANTS OF UP TO \$4,000 PER YEAR TO STUDENTS WHO INTEND TO TEACH IN A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL THAT SERVES STUDENTS FROM LOW-INCOME FAMILIES. TO RECEIVE A TEACH GRANT YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA: COMPLETE THE FAFSA, BE A U.S. CITIZEN OR ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN, BE ENROLLED IN A COLLEGE THAT HAS CHOSEN TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEACH GRANT PROGRAM, BE ENROLLED IN COURSEWORK THAT IS NECESSARY TO BEGIN A CAREER IN TEACHING, MEET CERTAIN ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT REQUIREMENTS ETC.
