Dear Gila Ridge High Parent/Guardian:

On **Tuesday, April 28, 2015**, Gila Ridge High School – along with all other high schools in our district– will administer the **ACT Exam** free of charge. **All JUNIORS** will take the **ACT** beginning at 7:30 a.m. **Juniors will report directly to their testing rooms at 7:30 a.m.** It is extremely important that juniors arrive **ON TIME**. **NO other students will be allowed on campus until 11:20 a.m.** No bells will sound until 11:25 a.m. There will be a double bus run in the morning, bringing all juniors in at the regular time, and all other students four hours later.

Freshmen, sophomores, and seniors will arrive for school by 11:20 a.m. At 11:30 a.m., all students will report to 5th period or lunch as outlined in the schedule below. They will then follow the schedule below for the remainder of the day.

It is important that all students-especially juniors-attend all classes and tests on time. It is each student's responsibility to make arrangements with employers or AWC instructors in the event that ACT testing conflicts with work or other commitments on this day.
