In this agreement, the District means Yuma Union High School District. The “Student” means the student, the “Parent” means the parent/legal guardian of the student enrolled in Yuma Union High School District. - Terms:** \*Student will comply at all times with the Yuma Union High School District’s Parent/Student Netbook Use Agreement as well as the Netbook Rules and Regulations outlined on the following page. Any failure to comply may terminate the student’s rights of possession effective immediately and the District may repossess the property.
- Title:** \*Legal title to the property is in the District and shall at all times remain in the District. The student’s right of possession and use is limited to and conditioned upon full and complete compliance with this Agreement.
- Loss or Damage:** \*If the property is damaged, lost or stolen, the student and parent are responsible for the cost of repair or its fair market value on the date of loss. Loss or theft of the property must be reported to the District (Campus Bookstore) by the next school day after the occurrence. Any manufacturer’s defects must also be reported immediately and no later than the next school day after the problem is identified.
- Repossession:** \*If the student does not timely and fully comply with all terms of this Agreement, the District shall be entitled to declare the student and parent in default and take possession of the property wherever the property may be.
- Term of Agreement:** \*The student’s right to use and possession is at the discretion of the District and/or parent/guardian.
- Appropriation:** \*The failure to return the property on time, and the continued use of it for non-school purposes without the District’s consent, may be considered unlawful appropriation of the District’s property.

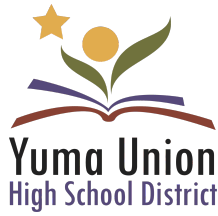

## Yuma Union High School District #70 Netbook Rules and Regulations for Students 2014 - 2015

The following rules and regulations pertain to the use and care of the Netbook issued by the Yuma Union High School District.

It is the student's responsibility to:

1. Bring the netbook to school each day with a fully charged battery.
2. Carry the Netbook in the case provided.
3. Never leave the Netbook unattended, with the exception of when the Netbook is in a school locker with a student owned lock in "lock position".
4. Never loan the Netbook to other individuals.
5. Clean the Netbook only with a soft cloth, like one would use with eyeglasses.
6. Never spray anything on or near the Netbook (like cleaners, hair spray, or air fresheners).
7. Keep food, beverages and ALL liquids away from the Netbook at all times in order to avoid damage to it.
8. Utilize the Netbook strictly for educational purposes.
9. Not deface the Netbook with any markers, engraving or stickers.
10. Not remove or change any district-applied labels.
11. Understand that the Netbook is subject to inspection at any time without notice.
12. Not install any personal software in the Netbook.

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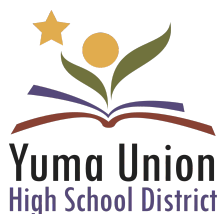

## Yuma Union High School District Netbook Repair and Insurance Notice 2014 - 2015

**Students are responsible for repair costs due to accidental damage. This is inclusive of, but not limited to: liquid spills, physical abuse, heat, or other forms of neglect.**  
**Students are responsible for lost or stolen netbooks.**

While each netbook is under warranty for manufacturer defects, the warranty does not cover accidental damage such as, but not limited to: cracked screens, damaged keyboards, etc.

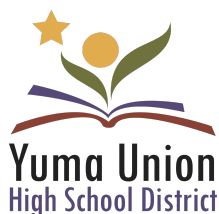
Should damage occur, the Yuma Union High School District will work with students and parents to provide one or more of the following repair options:

1. **For light damage** - The Yuma Union High School District will make an attempt to repair the unit at zero cost.
  - a. Based on availability of parts on hand.
    - i. Example: Missing keyboard keys
2. **For moderate damage** - The Yuma Union High School District will work with you on a reduced cost repair not to exceed \$100.00.
  - a. Based on the ease of swapping a broken part with a replacement part.
    - i. Example: Cracked Screen
3. **For all other damage or loss of device** - Parent will have the following options:
  - a. Pay the actual repair cost and retain the device, costs vary.
  - b. Pay a \$100.00 repair charge and receive a used device
  - c. Pay \$500.00 to replace the completely damaged or lost device.
  - d. Pay a \$100.00 repair charge and provide your student with your own device.

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### Homeowner's Insurance Notice

The netbook is the sole property of the Yuma Union High School District and as such it is unlikely that one's homeowner's insurance will cover any accidental damage or lost or stolen property claims. Check with your homeowner's insurance company before making any assumptions of coverage.



## Yuma Union High School District Refusal to Accept Netbook 2014 - 2015

In this agreement, the District means “Yuma Union High School District”. “I and my” refer to the parent/legal guardian of the student enrolled in Yuma Union High School District. “Son/daughter” refers to the student enrolled in Yuma Union High School District.

I waive my child’s right to utilize a Netbook provided by the Yuma Union High School District free of charge. I acknowledge that the student resource materials for all classes may be electronically provided, and therefore agree to provide a comparable device for him/her to use.

**I understand that if no device is provided, the student’s classroom success may be compromised.**

I understand the device I provide must meet the following technology standards:

- \*Wireless Internet Connection
- \*Anti-virus protection (for Windows based products)
- \*Word Processor (compatible with Microsoft Office products)
- \*Spreadsheet application (compatible with Microsoft Office products)
- \*Presentation software (compatible with Microsoft Office products)
- \*PDF Reader software

I agree that my son/daughter will download free software as required by teachers and the District in addition to the software listed above, as deemed necessary by the District. In the event the District purchases additional software for the Netbooks, I also agree to purchase the prescribed software for my son/daughter’s device in a timely manner at my own cost.

I understand that District Staff will not service, repair, maintain or otherwise support the device I provide, nor will my waiver of the access to the Netbook imply any responsibility of the District to provide technology access to my son/daughter.
