



Parental Involvement Policy

Page Middle School realizes the important role that parents play in the education of their children. We therefore, have developed a policy for parental involvement and communication between parents and Page Middle School. This policy will be updated yearly with the involvement of our student's parents.

1. It is Page Middle School's responsibility to provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective environment that enables the students to meet the State's academic standards.
2. Page Middle School will convene an annual meeting of parents and explain the rights of parents to be involved.
3. Page Middle School will respond in a timely manner to any suggestions or concerns of parents.
4. A School-Parent compact, which is a written agreement of what schools and parents are each supposed to do to help with the success of all students, will be reviewed with parents annually.
5. Page Middle School will address the importance of communication between teachers and parents on an ongoing basis through, at a minimum:
 - a. Parent-teacher conferences at least bi-annually, during which the compact can be discussed and available.
 - b. Frequent reports to parents on their child's progress (every three weeks)
 - c. Online access to child's grades and attendance through Power School program.
 - d. Access to staff, opportunities to volunteer with their child's class, and observation of classroom activities.
