Formation of the Youth Commission

On January 6, 2014, the Wickenburg Town Council approved the formation of a Youth Commission. This commission is an advisory group to the Mayor and Council. Their main objectives are to learn about local government, provide services to the community, develop personal leadership skills, and give a voice to the youth of Wickenburg.

This Commission consists of seven (7) members. Members must be residents who are actively enrolled in a public or private high school (including charter and home schools). The terms of the members commence and expire in June of each year.

Youth Commission's Functions and Duties

- Learn and experience the roles and responsibilities of local government officials.
- Evaluate and review problems facing the youth of the town.
- Facilitate meetings with youth to discuss problems, needs, and suggest improvements for the community.
- Meet at least quarterly with the Mayor and Town Manager to share ideas and discuss issues, concerns and needed improvements relating to youth issues in the community.
- Attend Town Council meetings and participate in vision and goal setting related to youth in the community.
- Present recommended improvements to the Town Council and Town Manager on public projects and programs relating to the youth in the community.
- Assist in planning youth recreational activities.
- Advise the Town Council and/or Town Manager on issues forwarded to the Wickenburg Youth Commission for evaluation.
