

Arizona Music Educators Association Individual Competition: Regional Honors Choir

1) What is Regional Honors Choir?

The Regional Honors Choir is a region-wide honors choir made up of high schools from around the Northwest part of Arizona. If they are admitted after the audition process, the students in the Regional Honors Choir participate in a concert/rehearsal weekend-long event where they have the opportunity to meet and perform with students from various high schools and a new director.

2) Important Information:

Audition Registration Deadline: 11/14/2014

Audition: Coconino High School, Flagstaff (January 23 OR 24, 2014)

Festival: Mohave High School, Bullhead City (February 20 - 22, 2014)

That means that if students decide that they would like to be part of the Regional Honors Choir, then they are committing to being available on January 23 OR 24 and February 20-22. Transportation will be provided by the school.

This also means that students are committing to preparing both the audition material required (one solo and practicing for sight-reading) and, if chosen to be part of the Regional Honors Choir, preparing their part on all of the music being sung that weekend.

3) There is one fee that must be paid by the student by Thursday, Nov. 13th, to the Bookstore. Cash or checks made out to WUSD. Because of fundraising efforts, all other fees will be covered by other sources (Yay!).

Fee = Registration Fee: \$20.00 – non-refundable

If the student would like to audition, then they will be required to submit the \$20.00 by Thursday, November 13th.

I have read the above information, and understand the requirements and fees necessary for my student to be part of this extra-curricular, optional event. If my student pays the \$20.00 registration fee, but chooses not to audition for the Regional Honors Choir, I understand that this fee is non-refundable.
