TOMBSTONE HIGH GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Tombstone High offers two separate diplomas, **Standard** and **Gold**. Both meet the graduation requirements adopted by the Arizona Board of Education and outlined in **R7-2-302.02**. The Gold diploma includes the classes required to meet the requirements of the **Arizona Board of Regents High Honors Tuition Scholarship**.

STANDARD

- · 4 credits English
- · 3 credits Social Studies
 - 1 credit World History
 - 1 credit American History, including Arizona
 - ½ credit American Government including Arizona
 - ½ credit Economics
- · 4 credits Mathematics
 - To include Algebra II
- 3 credits Science
- 1 credit Fine Arts or 1 credit CTE
- 7 Electives to include a completion of one of the CTE (Career Technical Education) Program.
 - The CTE requirement can be waived by the principal for students who first transfer to Tombstone High after the end of their junior year if scheduling does not allow for the completion of a CTE program

GOLD DIPLOMA

The district governing board establishes 24 credits as the minimum number of credits necessary for the attainment of a Gold diploma.

All requirements for the Standard diploma must be met as well as all of the following:

- 1. Honors English III and College Prep English IV or Eng 101/102
 - The requirement of honors English III can be waived by the principal for students who first transfer to Tombstone High after their junior year. AP English III can be used in place of honors English III.
- 2. 1 additional math credit, Math Analysis or higher.
- 3. 1 additional science credit, three credits of Science must be from lab science (not CTE).
- 4. Two units of foreign Language (must be in the same language)
 - i. The above CTE requirement can be waived by the principal for students who first transfer to Tombstone High after the end of their junior year if scheduling does not allow for the completion of a CTE program.
