
Cost

The cost is \$50 per semester course (0.5 credits per course) with a cap of \$100. What a deal! Turn in registration and payment at the Pima District Office

This means that students can earn as many credits as they can complete during summer school.

How does it work?

Students did not receive credit in a course due to excessive absences or a failing grade will be enrolled in a single course.

The student takes a pre-test to demonstrate what they already know & understand.

The student is then assigned lessons on what they did not master.

Students complete the assigned lessons and then take the final exam.

Students who pass the final exam with a 70% or better then complete the post-test and are awarded credit.

Students who score below 70% on the final exam take the post-test which will again assign lessons the student did not master.

The student completes these additional lessons and is awarded credit.

Students attempting multiple courses simply repeat the sequence above.
