8 three prong, two pocket folders **solid colors (2 blue, 2 red, 2 yellow, 2 orange)**

2 poly (plastic) envelopes

6-10 glue sticks

2 4oz. glue bottles

4 boxes of crayons **(8 crayons in a box)**

1 pack of pencils

1 pair of headphones **(No earbuds please)**
