This is a busy month with a lot of activities, progress reports, and Spring Break. A parent/teacher conference is an opportunity for you to discuss progress in reading and mathematics with your child's teacher. All children are assessed on standards from the quarter, and the classroom teacher can share strengths and areas of weakness your child might need more support with. During Spring Break practice by playing board games, word games, reading, counting objects around the house or outside, or reading travel brochures and maps to places you might visit. These activities will build on reading and math skills that they have learned throughout the school year.

Lake View will start early enrollment for Kindergarten this month. I encourage early registration so we can use the enrollment to place children in our summer KinderCamp program. This program supports children whom have not had the opportunity to attend pre-school, come from single parent homes, have parents with little or no college experience, or are Native American. Please stop by our office for your enrollment packet.

IMPORTANT: Lake View will not be taking teacher requests. We will send home a questionnaire for students enrolled in our school next year that will provide us information about your child and their needs. We will use current year's data, test scores, teacher input, and input from the questionnaire. Kindergarten placement will be based on information we obtain from pre-schools in the area about your child and parent input on the questionnaire.


21st Century After School Program

4 Ways to Strengthen Family Partnerships


- Welcome students and families with a letter in late summer by mail or email. Welcome students, introduce yourself, and tell families when the Open House or Meet the Teacher night is. Consider sending a family-student survey.
- Keep parents informed of what is happening in the school and classroom. Regular (bi-weekly or monthly) communication via email or newsletters helps families feel connected to the school. In the event that something negative does come up, parents are more likely to be receptive if they feel they have a connection to their children's school and teacher.
- **Be positive** with parents and students. Don't just call when Johnny has had a bad day, call randomly or to share good news. This will help build a positive rapport with parents.
- Conduct home visits when appropriate and allowed by administration to encourage family involvement. This allows you to meet parents and families in an environment where they feel comfortable as well as showing you took the extra effort to reach out to them.
