September flew by and October promises to be an exceptionally busy month full of activities at Page High School. Below is a list of activities and events that will be taking place at our school.

On October 5th, we will be hosting our annual College Fair for Seniors at the CAB from 8:00-9:15am. Parents are welcome to attend this event as both 2 year and 4 year colleges from the four corners states will be represented. Sen-

iors and parents will be able to get information from a college they may be interested in attending in the future. For those not able to attend this event, our 4th Annual College Readiness Night will be taking place on January 26th, 2016. Representatives from colleges, tech schools, and local scholarships will be present to provide students and parents with information about what they have to offer.

October is always highlighted by Parent/Teacher conferences at Page High School. As a reminder, we have moved this event to the Main Gym, which creates an open feeling where all of the teachers in all of the content areas can be easily found. Parent/Teacher conferences will run from 6:00-8:00pm on October 13th and 1:00-4:00pm on October 15th.
