**Subject:** Closed Campus at Lunch Update

At Tuesday night’s Governing Board Study Session, the work we have done in gathering student, staff, parent, and business feedback was presented to the Governing Board. The Governing Board was pleased with seeing the variety of options we have developed as a solution to the issue because there are many variables to consider with this issue. As I explained to them, the issue really is two pronged in that it is about student safety and about attendance before and after lunch.

The Governing Board would like to see more feedback from the outlying communities, so Mr. Varner and I will be meeting with Elouise Goatson-IEC Director to figure out the best way to get the feedback from parents who live on the reservation. As many of you who have been here a while know, this is no small feat.

The bottom line is that the Governing Board will be taking action on the item in December. Based on the feedback so far, I will be recommending the following to the Governing Board:

- a. Students will be required to register their vehicles with the school. They will be required to show a valid driver’s license at the time of registration. They will also be required to purchase a parking placard (this will be transferable among vehicles and the fee will be put on a sliding scale).
- b. Students will only be allowed to park in the CAB parking lot.
- c. Students will be allowed to walk off campus during lunch, but not drive.
- d. Students will be asked to take a “driver’s safety” course during the SD Block.
- e. We will ask the Governing Board to add a campus monitor position to help us better monitor the campus for safety issues.
- f. I will ask the Governing Board for their authorization to form a committee that will study how best to restrict the off campus lunch privilege for students who do not have good grades/attendance.

This is my tentative plan and could change between now and the December vote.

If you have questions, please ask. As always, your feedback is appreciated. I recognize that this is a divisive issue both for our students and our community; however, I believe that putting the above items in place is what is best for our students at Page High School.
