District Objectives

Methodology for Setting Goals

The basis for projections are facts, figures, and anticipated actions from various reputable sources such as agencies from Maricopa County government, Estrella Village government, the City of Phoenix, and the US Census Bureau. Using this information, statistical analysis and evaluation yielded projections for the next ten years.

Goals Summary

Student Enrollment

Using the information presented in the sections below, these projections for school enrollment or Average Daily Membership (ADM) were developed. The chart below shows growth through the next 10 years.

Faculty and Administration

- ◆ The District will closely monitor enrollment size every quarter to track actual growth to anticipated growth.
- ◆ Along with tracking growth, the District will set teacher/student ratio thresholds that trigger hiring new staff.



Private Education in a Public School Setting

- ◆ Using the actual growth data, the District will make reasonable projects as to when it will cross the teacher to student ratio thresholds and thus begin recruiting early.

Facilities

- ◆ Using the three to five year population projections, the current campus facilities will be adequate for the school population.
- ◆ As student population increases the District will consider expanding existing facilities. This allows prudent stewardship of public funds to increase utilization of Administration and Faculty, as well as transportation, food services, and maintenance. Additionally, it increases utilization of teachers with specialized skills, while managing class size, teacher location, parental preferences, and continuity of curriculum.

Education Delivery

- ◆ Improving the academic performance of English Language Learners will be aided by with “hands on” participation that many technology based tools provide. These supplement the teacher’s instructional capabilities by engaging the student in “fun” activities while subtly delivering English language skill.
- ◆ Embracing technology is a way to help student overcome the digital divide and be prepared for life in the 21st century. Additionally, it assists the teacher by helping identify areas where the student needs additional help and providing that help, without calling other student’s attention to that child’s special needs.



Private Education in a Public School Setting

- ◆ Technological innovations occur and are deployed with amazing rapidity. The District will monitor the efficacy of each technology tool vis-à-vis improved scores, teacher feedback, and education trends.

Expanding Education Horizons

- ◆ To be prepared for all the changes in our society, educators will reach out to the general population by providing programs such as a robust pre-k, after school enrichment for students, and adult education.

Community Participation

- ◆ The anticipated Aquatic Center and enhanced sports facilities at the Kings Ridge campus will fit the letter and spirit of Estrella Village's Master Plan perfectly. That Plan envisions neighborhood recreational facilities that should serve a population of 4,000 – 7,000 people living within a half mile radius of these facilities.
