

#1 Breakout Topic

#2 Breakout Topic

Challenge: How do we provide work-based learning experiences that will allow students to learn contextually in real-world workplace settings?

- Add more telephone training with a large emphasis on triaging the call.
- Implement a first year "Service Excellence" training so students are prepared for clinics.
- Teach students to reflect on their service times and overall time management during their clinic days.
- Have clinic participants participate in an exit poll after the service has been provided.
- Lists by program of mastered student skills should be created and provided to all intern partners on what students can perform.
- Increase number and types of internships within each program.
- Create a job board on the school's website to announce employers contacting CAVIT with open positions.
- A work-based learning packet would be beneficial for CAVIT to create so sites are knowledgeable about the program
