Nursing Assistant Teacher – CAVIT Campus, Coolidge 2014-2015 School Year

Job Summary

The Nursing Assistant Teacher will teach three, two hours classes/labs a day for 180 days. Additional days/time are compensated at the teacher's daily rate of pay. This rigorous two year program includes direct care worker training the first year and nursing assistant training the second year. This program is designed for students committed to a career in direct patient care. This course includes both advanced classroom instruction and clinical experiences at local medical facilities.

Personal Qualities

Good personal time management is a must as are patience, a sense of humor, and great communication skills both oral and written.

Duties

- Teaches direct care worker (1st year) and nursing assistant (2nd year) classes to prepare students to take the state licensure exams upon program completion
- Supervises students completing clinicals in healthcare agencies
- Accesses multi-media technology for instructional purposes
- Develops daily lesson plans upon which instruction and assessment are based
- Reports student enrollment data
- Works with teachers, administrators and business and industry to develop an active program advisory committee
- Assists students prepare for HOSA competitions

Job Requirements

- Demonstrated proficiency through 5 years or more work experience in the nursing field including 1 year work experience in a long term care facility and 1 year experience supervising/teaching adults
- Must meet Arizona Direct Care Worker and Arizona Board of Nursing instructor requirements
- Eligible for ADE CTE secondary teaching certificate
- Experience supervising and teaching adults and/or high school youth
- Ability to pass background/security check

Salary

This will be a 10-month position with a salary range from \$45,000 to \$66,297 depending upon experience.
