Session	Description
e-IEP PRO/e-ELL PRO Data Integration with Synergy SIS	The e-IEP PRO is a complete interoperable special education management software and the e-ELL PRO is a comprehensive English learner management software. Both software solutions provide secure, seamless, real-time data integration capabilities allowing for a single unified data solution between the district's student information system (SIS) and its special education and English learner data/information. For ETC LEAs, comprehensive data integration features are available between the e-IEP PRO, the e-ELL PRO and Synergy SIS that range from simple one-way data communication to more comprehensive two-way data integration options. Come learn how these free integration services can be easily setup and utilized by your school or district.
e-IEP PRO Data Management And Reporting	The session will provide participants a strong understanding of how to best utilize the e-IEP PRO's reporting and data management features. This session will review the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recommended "best practices" for keeping census and state reporting (AzEDS) data accurate within the e-IEP PRO; 2. Compliance Reports and Customized Reports available in the e-IEP PRO; 3. The e-IEP PRO Special Education Data Dashboard; 4. e-IEP PRO AzEDS Plug-In / Data Reporting features; 5. Building reports using e-IEP PRO's Ad-Hoc query and report writing tools; 6. Questions and answers specific to your district's needs.
Administrator Features Review for e-IEP PRO Primary System Administrators (PSAs)	This session is designed for e-IEP PRO Primary System Administrators who want to better understand the Administrator features of e-IEP PRO including: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student Profile Administrator Features; 2. Data Management; 3. Password Distribution Best Practices; 4. Add, change, and delete, user accounts throughout the entire district; 5. Add/set users as Primary Contacts and/or Primary System Administrators; 6. Add/set users as Transfer Contacts for the district; 7. Set/alter crucial system configuration/customization settings; 8. Merge duplicate student records and Restore deleted student records; 9. Accessing the Compliance Alerts for staff; 10. Reporting - Special Education Dashboard, Compliance Point and Click Reports, and Ad-Hoc Reporting.
End-User and Technical Review of the e-IEP PRO Online Portals	This session will review e-IEP PRO Portals and review data integration updates that can be made to improve the use of the portals. e-IEP PRO Portals that will be reviewed will include: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student Information Portal; 2. Parent Portal; 3. Transportation Communication Portal; 4. State Review Module; 5. Student Transfer Portal.
Review of the e-ELL PRO	The e-ELL PRO is a web-based English Learner (EL) student and forms management software designed specifically for Arizona education agencies, schools and districts. This session will review the features of the e-ELL PRO and how it is being utilized by Arizona LEAs to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Save staff time and resources; 2. Ensure proper EL forms and documentation are completed for all EL students; 3. Receive automated notifications of important EL documentation and action due dates; 4. Better manage required EL student information; 5. Enhance the ease of access to EL student information and documents by key district stakeholders, such as teachers and principals; 6. Electronically store historical and current EL student documentation; and, 7. Improve overall EL program compliance.
