


What is Title I and How Can I be Involved?

Definition of Title I:

- ▶ Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
 - ▶ Title I allocated to schools based on the percentage of student receiving free/reduced lunch.
 - ▶ All programs for new LEA (Local Education Agency) are initially Schoolwide.
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Ranch Elementary operates a
Title I Schoolwide Program.

Schoolwide Program means:

A school with a Title I Schoolwide Program, which is primarily addressed in [Section 1114 of Title I, Part A](#), is one that receives Part A funds “to upgrade the entire educational program of a school that serves an eligible school attendance area in which not less than 40 percent of the children are from low-income families, or not less than 40 percent of the children enrolled in the school are from such families”. The focus of a Schoolwide Program is Comprehensive Schoolwide Reform to ensure **all students** – especially those considered most academically at-risk – are able to attain academic proficiency based upon state academic standards.

Ranch has elected to use Title I funds to :

- ▶ Operate an after school tutoring program. The program services 2nd grade thru 6th grade students on Thursdays.
- ▶ Math Intervention
 - Accelerated Math
 - Paraprofessional support
- ▶ Reading Intervention
 - Reading Specialist
 - Paraprofessional support
 - Foundations Double Dose
 - Just Words
 - Paraprofessional support
- ▶ Summer School
- ▶ STARFALL
- ▶ BrainPop

Eligibility:

A Schoolwide Program uses Title I funds to support programs for eligible children, i.e., children who are failing, or at risk of failing, to meet the state's standards.
