During public participation, the Governing Board shall not hear personal complaints against school personnel or any other person connected with the District. Persons with complaints/concerns regarding District matters are referred to Governing Board Policies KE, KEB, KEC, and KED.

The Tolleson Union High School District No. 214 Governing Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Governing Board President Mr. Steven Chapman with the following members present: Mr. Devin Del Palacio, Ms. Corina Madruga, Mr. Vincent Moreno, and Mr. Freddie Villalon.

#### Approval of the Regular Agenda

Mr. Moreno moved to approve the Regular Agenda; seconded by Mr. Del Palacio. In a roll call vote, the motion carried 5-0.

#### **Public Participation**

There were no requests to address the Governing Board.

#### **Summary of Current Events**

#### Superintendent - Dr. Cunningham

- The District's annual health and wellness fair is on February 24 at the District Office. A variety of vendors will be onsite and various health screenings offered to staff.
- Since early May, 320 requests to update information on the District website were submitted. One hundred twenty-four requests were for changes to District Office associated web pages.
- La Joya Community High School hosted the second annual NASCAR Day. NASCAR driver Christian Celaya, who lives in Arizona and got his start in the Baja races, is a rising NASCAR star. Students had an opportunity to see a pace car and an actual NASCAR racing car. This annual event is possible through the District's partnership with Phoenix International Raceway.
- The Sierra Linda High School Lady Bulldogs are in the basketball quarter-finals. The Bulldogs take on Prescott and, if victorious, will play the winner of the Cactus Shadows/Arcadia game in the semi-finals.
- Eight University High School students were accepted into the STEP program, a two-year college
  preparatory program. Of the 43 students who were accepted from the Phoenix area, eight are from UHS
  and three from Tolleson Union High School.
- Westview High School will host an A<sup>+</sup> visit on March 17 and 18. Leaders from across the state will visit to determine if WHS should be awarded A<sup>+</sup> status.
- Fifteen James A. Green Continuing Education Academy students traveled to the state capital for a tour and to meet with several legislators. The students were also able to observe the legislature in action.
- Tolleson Union High School will host a Teach For America recruitment tour on February 25.
   Approximately 20 potential TFA candidates will spend the afternoon at TUHS visiting classrooms, meeting with students, and hearing about the TFA experience from TFA alums who are now teaching in the District.

B-1700 BEDB

■ The Board may vote to hold an executive session for the purpose of obtaining legal advice from the Board's attorney on any matter listed on the agenda pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(3).

#### Emergency meetings:

In the case of an actual emergency, the Governing Board, after giving such notice as is appropriate to the circumstances, may act on an emergency matter or call an emergency meeting in accordance with the requirements set out in A.R.S. 38-431.02. The emergency meeting shall follow the order of business for a special meeting. An emergency meeting shall be subsequently followed by the posting of a public notice within twenty-four (24) hours declaring that an emergency session has been held and setting forth the information specified by A.R.S. 38-431.02. Chapter 7 of the Arizona Agency Handbook shall be consulted for guidance when an emergency action or meeting is being considered.
