University of Phoenix Stadium Handicap ADA Parking and General Information

- At your assigned Gate there is handicap parking for those cars having a handicap hanger/or license plate. Please refer to your map to locate the wheelchair symbol.
- There are limited numbers of wheelchairs available to check out at each entry. They are on a first come, first serve basis. You must sign them out and return them to the Gate you entered. Wheelchairs may not leave the inside of the building.
- It is suggested that if your guest has trouble walking or needs a wheelchair, getting your own wheelchair for the day is preferred.
- For those guests who have difficulty walking, there is a handicap drop off/turn around area in the lot marked "Staff and ADA Parking" area near GATE 2 located off 95th Avenue. You will be allowed to drop off those who cannot walk very far and they may enter Gate 2. You will then need to park in your assigned parking lot and enter your assigned GATE and meet your family member or guest inside at Gate 2 area that is directly across from the North end zone seating area. This drop-off is ONLY for those with difficulty walking or using wheelchairs and an escort.

PLEASE keep in mind this is a very large stadium and walking to the Gate and around to the seating area is a long distance so please plan accordingly. As stated above, providing your own wheelchair is suggested.

Prohibited Items List Trade Shows, Consumer Shows, Meetings, Graduations

Attendees are reminded that the following items will not be permitted inside the University of Phoenix Stadium. There are no lockers available outside of the stadium to secure items not allowed inside nor can any items be held by security staff members.

- Air horns or other artificial noisemakers.
- Alcohol
- Animals (except for service animals)
- Balloons (helium)
- Banners or signs with advertising
- Beach balls
- Beverages other than one factory sealed non-frozen 500ml (16.9 oz.) bottle of water
- Bicycles, skateboards, Segway's, wheelies or roller blades
- Cameras with professional photo lenses (larger than 8"), tripods or monopods
- Clothing deemed obscene or indecent
- Confetti, glitter or streamers
- Containers: Water bottles (metal, glass or other materials) or Canteens
- Coolers of any kind
- Fireworks or sparklers
- Food (except for children under the age of 2 or those with medical condition)
- Illegal drugs
- Silly String
- Smokeless cigarettes
- Weapons--including but not limited to firearms and knives
- Any item deemed inappropriate or hazardous by stadium security
