## Principal's Message

This month allows me to share with you some very positive news for Combs Traditional Academy. We are very excited to share that we continue to be one of the top rated schools in the area, with the state's release of individual school performance on last spring's AzMERIT testing. Overall, we had the highest passing rate of any school in Pinal County and San Tan Valley in both Mathematics and English Language Arts. For both English Language Arts and Mathematics, our 4th and 5th graders had the highest passing percentage in the county. Our 4th graders were in the top 15 of all schools and top 5 public schools in the state for ELA and our 5th graders were in the top 5% of all public schools in the state for Mathematics.

We also had our first induction ceremony on Thursday, September 29th for the National Elementary Honor Society. The fourteen 5th and 6th grade students that were inducted had to qualify based on grades, then apply for membership including an essay. A team of staff members reviewed each application and recommended students for membership based on the NEHS principles of Scholarship, Service, Leadership, Character, and Citizenship. They will now meet on a regular basis to continue to take a leadership role at CTA in terms of those principles and we will hold annual inductions of new students in the spring. We look forward to seeing our NEHS membership grow and continue to showcase the excellence that is Combs Traditional Academy!

Please don't forget some of the important dates coming up! Fall break is just around the corner during the week of October 10th. Students return on October 18th. We will have our first Recognition Assemblies for Honor Roll and Student Attendance on October 21st. PTO will be hosting a Peter Piper Pizza Night on October 28th. On November 4th, our first Battle of the Books will be held with 5th and 6th grade teams showing what they have learned over the first four books on the list. And please remember to register to vote by October 10th!

Thank you for your continued support of Combs Traditional Academy and the J.O. Combs Unified School District. We use the number pad to type in their numbers, so letting them practice typing on the number pad will also aide them in learning to log on.

## Nurse's Corner

Help us keep CTA happy and healthy! Please keep your child home if they have any of the following symptoms:

- \*Fever- Temperature of 100.0° or greater. Child must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication before they can return to school.

- \*Pink Eye- Child may return to school once they have been on antibiotics for 24 hours


