Hello from the CTA Health Office,

We wanted to take a minute to let you know of our OTC medication policy. If your child is needing to take an over the counter medication while in school we will need an adult to physically bring the medication into the health office. All medications must be in original packaging with labels and directions intact on the container. These medications will require an over the counter permission slip to be filled out and signed by the parent. You may do this when you bring the medication into the health office. Some examples of over the counter medications would be Ibuprofen, cough drops, Benadryl and topical ointments. These medications should not be brought in by the student. ## **Orchestra Message**

Dear Parents,

**Beginning Orchestra Students:** are learning to play "E and F#" on the "D String" while "Tunneling:" a technique that requires pressing fingers down to play "F#" at the same time while playing open "A String," "Tunneling" is a concept that is necessary for playing more difficult music. We are also learning to distinguish and play Eighth Notes in groups of "2" and in "4."

Advanced Orchestra Students: are learning to play "Tied Notes," "Slurs," "C#" and "C Natural," "Two Octave G Scale and Arpeggio," which requires: Viola, Cello and Bass to "Shift" while the Violins learn to play on their "High E String."




