The Mission of the La Paz County Food Banks is to relieve hunger, increase self-reliance, and improve the quality of life for children and families throughout La Paz County.

Please DO NOT contact the Community Resource Department to discuss eligibility. Screening for eligibility will be performed at the Food Banks during the hours of operation listed below and not by telephone. Generally speaking, anyone who is currently unemployed and/or with an income which is 185% of the federal poverty level or below will qualify for some form of service if they are able to demonstrate residency in La Paz County.

Individuals wishing to VOLUNTEER may contact the Community Resource Department or appear in person at either of the Food Banks or the Community Resource Department to pick up an application. All ages and ability levels of volunteers are encouraged. Individuals needing to complete community service are also welcome.

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

TEFAP consists entirely of USDA product received through the federal and state government. TEFAP boxes are distributed daily at the La Paz County
