You can pay for one at a time between now and March 11th. Bookstore hours 8:00 am to 3:30 pm





After years of discussion among community leaders, educators and policymakers about how to improve education in Arizona, the new <u>Arizona Education Progress Meter</u> was developed by <u>Expect More Arizona</u> and the <u>Center for the Future of Arizona</u> to provide a roadmap for success. Our two nonpartisan, nonprofit organizations have collaborated to elevate shared aspirations for education in Arizona, including a set of widely accepted indicators by which Arizonans can measure progress, celebrate successes and take action together.

<u>Eight primary metrics</u> will be used to gauge progress being made in the education of Arizona students.
