 - 2. <u>Settlement Agreement and Teacher Resignation</u> Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03 (A)(1), Personnel, the Board may vote to move into executive session to discuss the settlement agreement and resignation of a teacher. If the teacher requests that this discussion be held in open session, it will be held during the action agenda portion of the agenda following the return to open session.
 - Dispute with the Arizona School Risk Retention Trust "the Trust" Pursuant to ARS 38-431.03.
 (A)(4)the Governing Board will enter into executive session to discuss the ongoing litigation and potential settlement with the Trust.
