All persons desiring to address the governing board must first be recognized by the Board President. Before speaking, the individual must state his/her name. Duration of comments may be limited by the Board President. Specific problems or concerns regarding personnel must be addressed through the provisions of the Public Complaint Policy. At the end of the call to the public, members of the Governing Board may respond to criticism, ask staff to review a matter, or ask that a matter brought up during the call to the public be put on a future agenda. *The Open Meeting Law does not permit the board members to take legal action to items not on the agenda.*
