

Elementary registration is for all students that did not pre-register in the spring, both new to MESD *and* returning. Students new to the district are encouraged to enroll as soon as possible.

Middle and High School Students' Class Schedules will be available for returning and pre-registered new students at the times listed above. Student fees may be paid and PE uniforms may be purchased when picking up class schedules or at time of registration. If unavailable on designated dates, schedules may be picked up during regular office hours after the dates above.
