What is a Pathway?

Starting with the Class of 2017 the Georgia Department of Education is mandating that each student graduates with a pathway in order for students to graduate career and college ready. A pathway is where your student selects an area of interest in their courses during high school.

What if my student changes their mind?

Students may change their pathway as long as the student meets the requirements for a pathway at the time of graduation.

Does the selected pathway affect diploma type?

No, there is only one type of diploma that all students are working towards and that is a general diploma. Your pathway has no impact on the diploma it just gives students the opportunity to explore their areas of interest.
