Text-to-World Connection (Ch. 1-3)

Make a text-to-world connection between these chapters and a world issue or current event. Explain the connection in one paragraph. Include page numbers from the book as well as citations for any sources used.

Text-to-Self Reflection (Ch. 1-3)

Write a three-paragraph personal reflection on chapters 1-3 including connections to your own experiences. Use specific details and images in your description.

Vocabulary (Ch. 4-6)

Choose 3 vocabulary words from each chapter (4, 5, and 6) that you do not know, for a total of 9 words. These can be academic vocabulary, scientific terms, etc. Record the words and definitions. and when you are finished, create a free crossword puzzle with 9 words and answer key:

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Creative (Ch. 7-9) Choose one:

- ♣ Design a new book cover reflecting key concepts or themes from chapters 7-9.
- ♣ Construct a model, chart or graph based on chapters 7-9.

Include a short paragraph explaining your choices.

Digital Collage, Wordle, or Meme (Ch. 7-9)

Create a digital collage, Wordle, or Meme to represent key concepts in chapters 7-9. Include/ attach at least three supporting quotations from these chapters. Include page numbers/citation. Bring a printed copy with attached

quotations to class.

Problem/Solution (Ch. 7-9)

Write a paragraph describing a problem and/or solution evident in chapters 7-9. Include 1-2 quotations from these chapters for textual support. Include page numbers/citation.

Summer Required Reading: All rising 9th grade students are required to read *The Demon in the Freezer* by Richard Preston and complete the Think-Tac-Toe assignment.

Directions: Complete 3 activities described above using a "tic-tac-toe" pattern. Your direction may be HORIZONTAL or DIAGONAL. You may NOT choose 3 in the same column; each activity must deal with a different set of chapters. No matter which direction you choose, your middle box will be Vocabulary (Ch. 4-6).
