# DC COMPOSITION AND SPEECH

- Still to be offered through Indiana University and still the same cost to our families

- Students will earn the same credit through this program that they would have earned through the ACP program used in past years

# DC COMPOSITION AND SPEECH

- Students will have to meet admissions requirements for IU in order to participate in this program
  - See transcripts for personal information on your status
  - Students must be in the top 50% of their class
  - Students must earn SAT or PSAT scores of 1030 (new test) or 950 (old test) or have an ACT composite score of 20
- If you need additional testing IU Kokomo is offering the ACT test this Friday – this is the final available opportunity for students to meet the admissions requirement. We will provide transportation to and from the testing.

# DC COMPOSITION AND SPEECH

- Additional ACT information
  - Testing begins at 12:50 but students need to arrive 20 minutes prior to testing. **The bus will leave Madison Grant at 11:30.**
  - Students will need a photo ID
  - Students will need number 2 pencils (several as a sharpener will not be available)
  - Calculator – standard 4 function, scientific, or graphing calculators are permitted
  - Snacks and water
    - We have plenty of pencils and calculators available to students just see Ms. Bragg
