Scholarship Application Process

1. Available scholarships are listed on the guidance page of the Madison-Grant Website and more information if available in the Guidance Office at Madison-Grant High School. New Scholarship opportunities arrive throughout the school year so check frequently for updates.
2. Check the criteria carefully to see if you are eligible to apply.
3. The scholarship application procedure varies:
 - ❖ Open application
 - You may go to the scholarship's website and fill out an application online.
 - You may pick up a copy of an application in the guidance office.
 - ❖ School Selected
 - Some scholarships require the school to select a nominee. If you are interested in applying for the scholarship, you can nominate yourself for consideration by talking with Ms. Bragg.
 - ❖ Committee-Selected
 - A minimum number of scholarships are not available for students through open application or self-nomination. Students will be notified if they have been selected for one of these scholarships.
4. Students should drop off completed applications to the guidance office at least two weeks before the deadline if a transcript or counselor recommendation is needed.
