#### **Vision & Hearing Testing, September 25**

Maryland Vision & Hearing will be coming to St. Mary's to offer vision and hearing screenings to all students. According to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, undetected vision problems are common in school age children. One in four school age children have a vision difficultly. Approximately 6% of children have hearing loss. Difficulties with hearing and/or vision can seriously impact learning and contribute to issues in both behavior and socialization. Early intervention is essential. The sooner a vision or hearing problem is detected; the more likely it can be corrected, helping your child to achieve their full potential in school.

MD Vision & Hearing technicians have over 30 years of experience in vision and hearing screening for children and adolescents. Vision screening for all children, beginning at age 3, consists of visual acuity and muscle balance. Children in grades 1-8 are also screened for color blindness. For hearing screening, your child is screened for the ability to hear a variety of tones that are within the normal range of hearing. To have your child screened, complete the form attached to this newsletter The form will also be sent home with your child(ren) today. Return the form to school with cash, check, or money order by September 25. Make checks payable to Maryland Vision & Hearing.


#### **Tuition Assistance Applications**
