Standards-Based Report Cards

Our Diocese has adopted a standards-based reporting system for our Catholic schools. Since our reports cards in grades TK-5 will be focused on students' progress towards mastery of a specific set of standards, the report card format will no longer have letter grades. *There will be a mandatory meeting for TK-5th grade families on Wed, Nov. 9th in the Small Gym to discuss the new standard-based report cards.* During this meeting we will take the time to explain all aspects of the new standards-based reports so that you have a clear understanding of this new Diocesan system when you receive your child's first trimester report card on Wed, Nov. 30th.

Keeping Our School Community Safe

Please inform everyone who drives your children of our school traffic procedures to ensure the safety of all members of our school community. Please review the diagram and follow the safety guides below:

- Follow the established traffic patterns. There is only ONE line for cars to drop off or park.
- Please do **NOT** park or drive through the No Car Zone-Cones mark this area. If you park on the other side of the church (near St. Bede Lane), please do **NOT** drive or park next to the baseball field because that creates unsafe traffic congestion in both directions.
- Pedestrians should follow the marked paths and cross at designated crosswalks. Please do **NOT** walk along the Small Gym or through the parked cars.
- Please hold your child(ren)'s hand(s) when walking through the parking lot so they are safe at all times. They cannot be seen by other drivers.
- *After school* school procedures are to park your vehicle, walk to the gate, and pick up your child(ren) in the designated areas.
- Please be patient, drive slowly, and be mindful of your surroundings.
