The state of California requires all incoming 7th grade students to have proof of a whooping cough Tdap booster shot before they can begin the school year. Please provide an updated medical record indicating that your child has received the immunization booster to the school office by

Thurs, June 15th. In the past students have not been able to come to school because the child had not received the Tdap booster or the proper paperwork from the doctor's office had not been completed. Our state prohibits entry into 7th grade without this medical requirement. Thank you for your attention to this important matter.
