# Preparing for an Emergency

On Wednesday, October 12th, we will conduct our vearly Emergency Evacuation Drill. We will assign staff members various roles, evacuate all children from the school building, and implement a process for students to be picked up from school. Pick-up will take place at the softball field where students will be lined up in alphabetical order according to the oldest sibling. Students will only be released to *adults listed on the emergency form*. Everyone must present a valid I.D. in order for the student(s) to be released from the school. *Please be sure to update* your emergency contact information and arrange for your child(ren) to be picked up at 12:00 PM. There will be NO afternoon Extended Care on Oct. 12th so that we can practice what would take place in a real emergency. Thank you for your active support in ensuring that our school community is safe and prepared for an emergency.
