

BABOQUIVARI UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD VACANCY

Pima County School Superintendent Linda Lee Arzoumanian hereby makes a public notice of the opportunity for the residents of **BABOQUIVARI UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT** to serve as a member of the Governing Board. There are <u>TWO</u> vacant seats on the Governing Board subject to appointment. The appointments will begin on the date of the appointment and will continue through December 31, 2018. These positions will be on the November 2018 general election ballot, one as a special, two-year term and the other for a regular, four-year term.

Board candidate questionnaires are available from the Office of the Pima County School Superintendent located at 200 N. Stone Avenue, in Tucson or at the District Office located at Highway 86, Mile Post 115.5 in Sells. Applications are due by **Monday, December 19, 2016 at 5:00PM.**

Eligibility requirements to serve at the time of appointment:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident and registered voter of the State of Arizona
- Be a resident of Baboquivari Unified School District for one year prior to the date of appointment
- Employees of the District and their spouses are ineligible.
- Immediate family members of current Board members who have shared the same household in the last four years are ineligible.
