

2015 SAT RESULTS

Much has been made in the news about the importance of standardized testing for elementary school children. Concerns are high that children in the Los Angeles area are scoring below the national norms. We at Woodcrest School are very happy to share our most recent Stanford Achievement Test results:

At Kindergarten, our students' average scores were:

Total Reading performance of our Kindergarten students was at the grade level of 2nd Grade plus 3 months, with the Total Math section also being scored on the average of 2nd Grade plus 2 months. Our Basic Battery score was 2nd Grade plus 2 months.

At 1st Grade, our students' average scores were:

The Basic Battery performance of our first grade students was at the level of 3rd Grade plus 4 months. The Total Reading and Math scores were at the 3rd Grade level plus 5 months and 3rd Grade level plus 4 months respectively. In Total Reading, 99% of the first grade students were "above the average". Our average 1st Grade score in Language (English Grammar) was 4th Grade plus 4 months.

At 2nd Grade, our students' average scores were:

Total Reading performance was at the level of 5th Grade plus 1 months as well as our Total Math at 4th Grade plus 8 months. Language was at the 5th Grade plus 8 months level. In Reading Comprehension 94% of our students performed at above the average. The Basic Battery score was 5th Grade plus 7 months.

At 3rd Grade, our students' average scores were:

Total Reading, 7th Grade plus 2 months, and Total Math, 8th Grade plus 4 months. In Language, the average was 10th Grade plus 2 months, with a Basic Battery score of 8th Grade plus 2 months. Our third graders scored 7th Grade plus 6 months in Thinking Skills and 7th Grade plus 3 months in their Social Studies.

At 4th Grade, our students' average scores were:

Total Reading, 8th Grade plus 2 months and Total Math, 8th Grade plus 5 months, with a Basic Battery of 9th Grade. Our fourth grade average score in Social Studies was 8th Grade plus 6 months with Science at 9th Grade plus 9 months.

At 5th Grade, our students' average scores were:

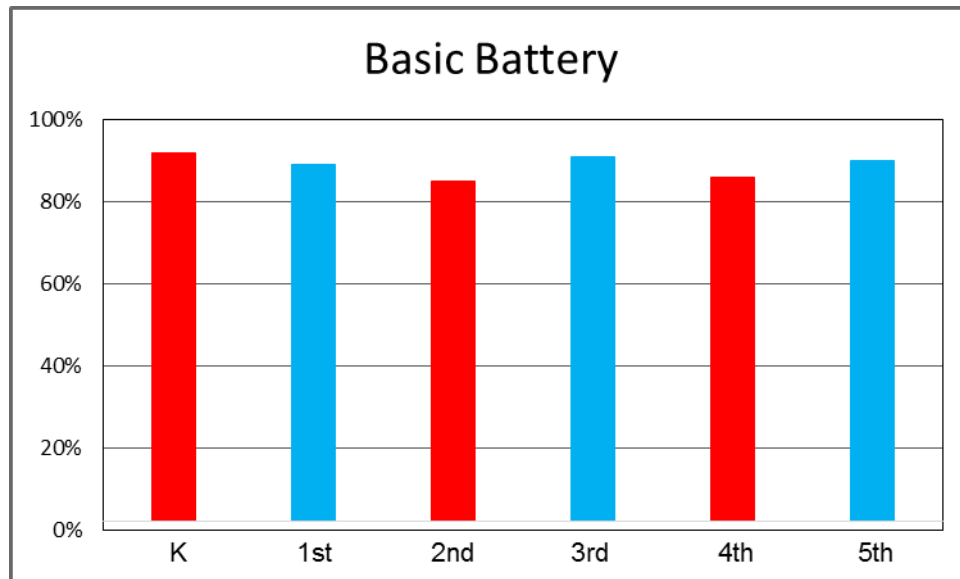
Total Reading, 9th Grade plus 1 month and Total Math, 10th Grade plus 3 months with a Basic Battery score of 10th Grade plus 8 months. Our average 5th Grade score in Language (English Grammar) was 10th Grade plus 8 months and 10th plus 1 month Grade in Social Studies.

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The national percentile norm is another means of evaluating students' academic ability. The national percentile is posted at fifty percent. 97% of Woodcrest students scored above this national average. The average score of a Woodcrest student in Grades K-5 was 88% on the national percentile norm for the Basic Battery. The Basic Battery includes all subtests in Reading, Math, and Language Arts. This means that for every 100 students tested, Woodcrest students, on the average, scored higher than 88 students out of 100.
