We're excited to send you "Stand Up, Stand Out," a report on our achievements, challenges, and initiatives for the past two fiscal years, FY12 and FY13. It's filled with stories and photos that reveal the remarkable growth of our students that has become a hallmark of our school.

Public and Catholic elementary and high schools have suffered severe budget strains resulting in widespread consolidations, program cuts, and closures. His tireless efforts drew in many new friends to support our mission while his leadership and care for our students left an imprint on so many lives. We are thrilled that he's remained on our board. Father Stephen Thorne stepped in skillfully as our parish's new pastor and our school's Board President bringing in his unique gifts and enthusiasm which we can see will be a tremendous blessing for the journey ahead.

And the changes and challenges ahead of us are in no way insignificant. We must keep up with rising program and technology costs to ensure our students can continue to compete well in high school and beyond. In the year ahead, we must replace our outdated computer lab equipment and finalize classroom renovation plans. And our long awaited science lab needs to move from design to execution in the near term to give our students greater employment options in our science-oriented region.

Your friendship and support are the bedrock of our confidence and determination to achieve these goals, setting our students on the path to great futures. As you read through this report, we hope you will see and feel the aspirations, hopes and dreams of the boys and girls who walk through our doors each day. Your investment in their lives gives them the opportunity to "Stand Up, and Stand Out", turning dreaming and believing into achieving.

2011-2012 Student Highlights

Two years ago, our Class of 2012 struggled; they tested more than a grade equivalent level behind in reading.

With your support, we introduced Advanced Reading classes. The curriculum, unfamiliar and challenging in our inner-city setting, emphasized higher-level thinking and raised the bar considerably. Our students met the challenge: they grew more than three grade equivalent levels and graduated at the equivalent level of a 10th-grader in reading.

2012-2013 Student Highlights

In 2012, our 7th-grade boys and girls tested about a half-grade equivalent behind on standardized tests in reading and math. But, in just one year's time, thanks to the combined effects of Advanced Math and Advanced Reading classes, we watched their scores rise three grade equivalent levels higher on standardized tests, giving them a big head-start on their all-important 8th-grade year.

THERE IS SOMETHING SPECIAL ABOUT HIM

Listening to alumnus Vince Cannady sing today, it is hard to picture the shy student who came to SMdPS in the mid-'90s. But, when a teacher saw – and heard – something special in Vince, she urged him to join the parish's church choir. The choir, his teachers' encouragement, and his growing confidence led to an audition for the highly selective Keystone State Boychoir, with which he sang on six of the world's seven continents. In 2013, this former self-described "wallflower" even took himself to New York City to try out for the hit NBC show "The Voice."

In May 2013, he graduated from Berklee College of Music in Boston. At the ceremony, singer Annie Lennox gave the commencement speech and Vince was featured soloist on her tune, "Here Comes the Rain Again." Earlier in the day, Ms. Lennox overheard Vince's rehearsal and offered some coaching. "As a singer," Vince later said, "it's just so incredible to sit down and to sing for her, and have her sing to me, and give me words of encouragement. I couldn't be happier!" "You can do this," Ms. Lennox told Vince before the ceremony began, and she was right. But Vince's St. Martin de Porres School family already knew that Vince can do just about anything!



A STAND OUT IN ACADEMICS

• In 2010-11, students across the school improved an average of 1 to 3 grade equivalents due in large part to improved use of technology and our new Advanced Math program. Building on that success, in 2011 we added Advanced Reading for the top third of our middle-schoolers. Reading classics like *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* and *Oliver Twist*, they learned to understand a writer's "voice" and do literary analysis, with overwhelming results: graduating 8th grade students tested at the 10th-grade equivalent, preparing them well for the rigors of high school.

• When they evaluated us in the Spring of 2012, the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools gave us high praise for the outcomes of our advanced classes and a general rise in expectations across all disciplines. Citing our "rigorous academic environment," their resulting accreditation affirmed that we are achieving the excellence we strive for every day.

• To head off the dip in math scores that typically shows up in middle grades, we launched the "Global Scholars" online test 2011-12. Instead of the model that produces data just once a year, Global Scholars gives us immediate, child-specific results three times each year. We mined the data to give attention when and where most needed, building an approach grounded in focused remedial and advanced instruction, producing improved classroom and individual outcomes.



• Thanks to a 21st Century grant administered by Catholic Social Services, we extended our school day in 2012 by 1½ hours, with benefits to our students such as more in-depth music instruction and participation in hands-on science and art projects. At midyear, our middle-schoolers began to learn Spanish. Teaching our students solid STEM-focused skills (science, technology, engineering and math) aligns with our commitment to preparing them to compete successfully for the science and technology jobs of the not-so-distant future.

AND TECHNOLOGY

Keeping up with technology is a challenge for any school. But under the leadership of veteran technology teacher Bell Gallagher, we are headed in the right direction. Though only part-time in 2011-12, Bell began broadening our students' use of the internet through intra-class blogging and grade-level web pages, packed with apps and sites that proved invaluable in many of their classes. Bell also carried technology instruction outside her classroom, coaching our teachers in ways to harness its benefits across the many subjects they teach.

Thanks to generous board members, we introduced iPads this year – at the kindergarten level! – to acclimate even our youngest students to the new technology. Kindergarten teacher Dotty McCarthy says the iPads give students a needed boost, especially if they are shaky with letters or sounds. With the early reading apps available on iPads, "you really see the progress," she said. "Within two months, they're writing sentences, words."

This year, other donors purchased two classroom-size iPad carts, so our iPads can rotate among classrooms. In classrooms like Ralph Price's sixth grade, our students are making great gains in math, using a wide array of instructional apps.

Technology has opened an ever-widening door to learning opportunities, and we will continue to stride through it in the coming years. Every day, we strengthen our commitment to creating and sustaining a vibrant and vital 21st-century learning environment that will equip our students for the ever-changing competitive environments they will face upon graduation.



SPONSOR-A-STUDENT



Since we began our Sponsor-A-Student program in 2011, it has significantly changed sponsors and students alike. On the faces of the 51 students sponsored to date, we see the confidence that comes from knowing they can remain enrolled in the school they have grown to love. We hear and see their happiness when they tell of meeting their sponsors, sharing a meal at the yearly Sponsor-A-Student events, reading to their sponsors, or boasting of beating their sponsor at checkers again.

Sponsors talk about Sponsor-A-Student with the same enthusiasm. They proudly display their students' artwork or photos in their offices. Some, like Jeff Wilkins or Kay and Jerry Lafferty (St. Katharine of Siena parish) affix their students' photos to their refrigerators as daily reminders of the children's importance in their lives. "My wife and kids and I pray for our sponsored student every night," says Jeff.

Tuition covers only a fraction of the costs of educating a child at St. Martin de Porres School. Every family contributes to tuition, but our students come from some of the region's poorest households and their families must dig deep into very limited resources. Sponsor-A-Student helps bridge the gap. Each sponsorship pledge means that the sponsored student stays with us in an environment that is purposeful, enriching and life-changing.

Every day, they instill a love of learning, ignite imaginations, encourage confidence, and impart the skills our children will use as they take their places in the greater Philadelphia region.

Their credentials are impressive: they have an average of 9 1/2 years' teaching experience at St. Martin de Porres Catholic School; nine have post-graduate degrees; and one is enrolled in graduate courses at an area university. They collaborate intensely on departmental and classroom preparation and share their learning generously, using new technology and exploring educational resources. Their demographics reflect our region: they are diverse in gender, race and age.

Visitors to the school remark on the impact our teachers have on our students' lives, inspiring attentiveness and determination to aim high in academic and life achievements. In story after story, our supporters hear our graduates recount the pivotal role their teachers play. Recently, a student who went on to graduate from the University of Massachusetts said, "My time at St. Martin de Porres helped build my confidence and inspiration to do well in life. The teachers provided me with so much positive feedback and encouragement . . . they believed in me and my potential." That's the St. Martin de Porres School difference!



ANNUAL GALA

We launched the 2012 gala fundraising in February at the Racquet Club of Philadelphia with a “roast” of Kevin Flynn, Sr., our 2012 gala honoree. Seventy guests attended this festive and high-spirited tribute featuring a comical student skit and good-natured jibes and tributes from Kevin’s close friends and colleagues, highlighting his one-of-a-kind personality and generous support of our school.

The 2012 gala, in March, featured the talents of 18 of our graduating 8th graders, depicting famous African Americans in our now famous “wax” museum. Sponsors and guests enjoyed interaction with students over a meal of great food in the fabulous atmosphere of the Diamond Club at Citizens Bank Park, home of gala sponsor Philadelphia Phillies. Total funds raised reached just over \$94,000.

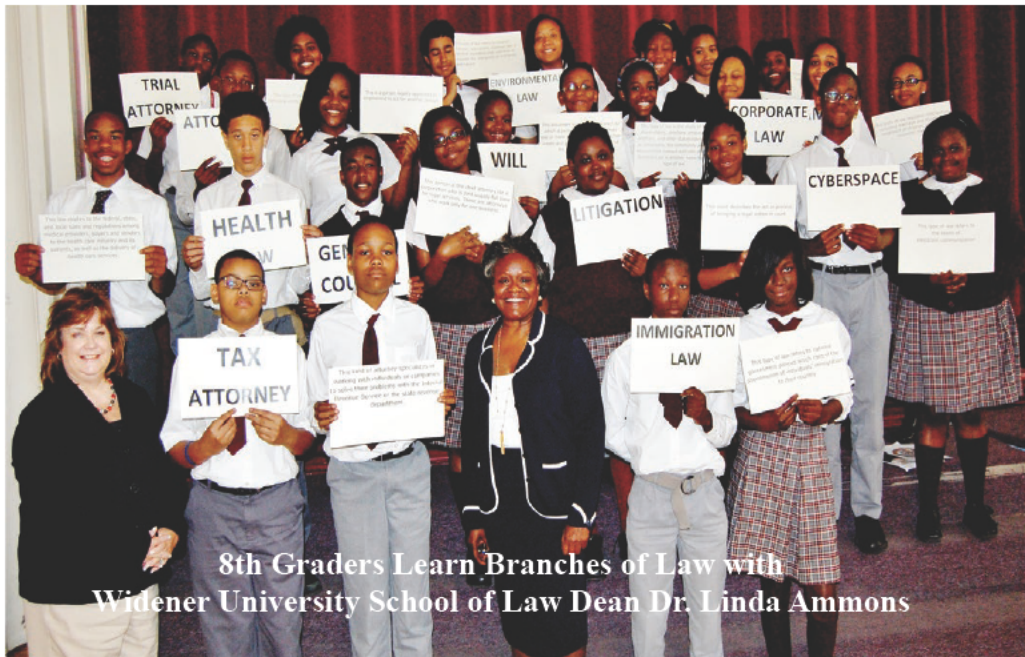

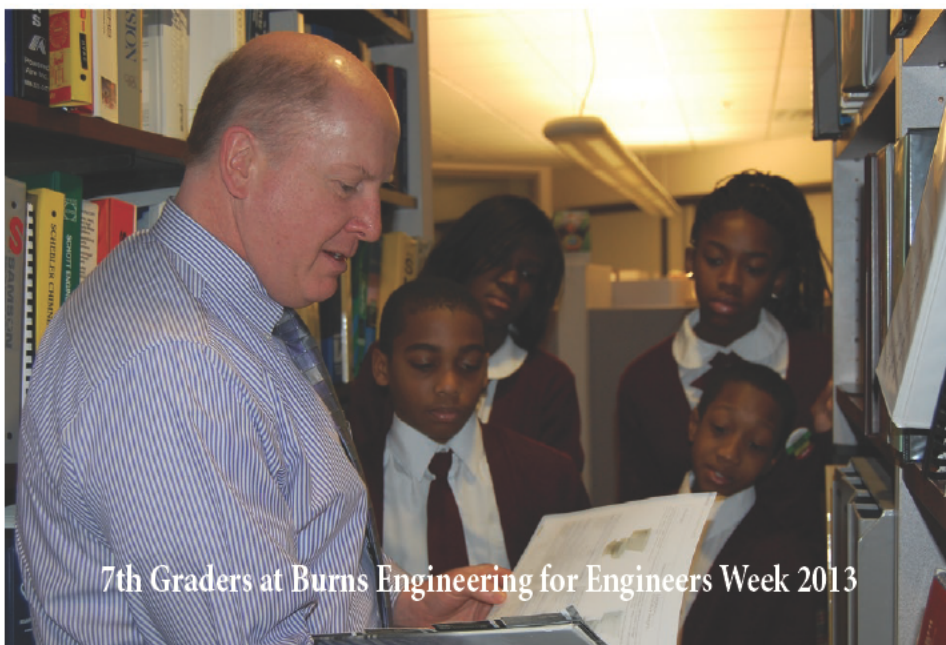

- Companies contributed \$255,000 toward scholarship funds in 2013, through Education Improvement Tax Credits (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credits (OSTC). They got a combined dollar-for-dollar tax credit of 90% -- that's \$229,500 -- against corporate state income tax, while covering a significant portion of SMdPS students' tuition.

- Middle school students learned personal finance and ran a business selling snacks to their classmates, under the direction of Julius Green and LaChantee Webb of ParenteBeard and Maureen Renzi of Pennsylvania Institute of CPAs. This year, our students will shadow professionals on "CPA-for-a-Day" and will expand their snack sales offerings.

- For two consecutive years, Iroko Pharmaceuticals has involved 175 5th- through 8th-graders in engaging, hands-on activities at our school. Iroko's scientists have taught students about key processes, like classifying bacteria and taking a drug from concept to market, at the same time modeling promising career opportunities for their futures.

- Local professionals volunteered as mentors and were matched to SMdP classrooms. They brought business savvy and life wisdom to our students. Last year, 6th-graders studied the stock market with their mentor, picking stocks that returned 10% on their "investment," getting a strong sense of how their SMdP studies can put them on the path to a meaningful career.

- The Rotary Club of Philadelphia partnered with SMdP to launch the Rotary Beacon correspondence program. In letters exchanged each month, ten SMdP 8th-graders sharpened their writing skills as they exchanged ideas and discussed career choices and the value of community service with their Rotarian "pen pals."
